Considering that:

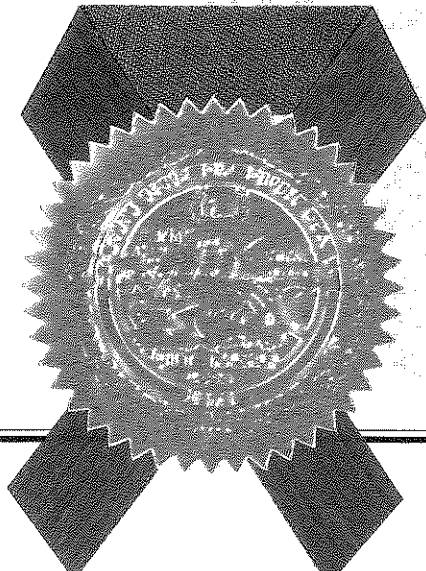
